1. Opening.

4. Financial Information.

Bas gives an overview of the financial situation of FIERBA. As you all can see we still have enough cash flow to do things that we think are necessary. Every country has paid his annual fee though everything is going all right.

The financial situation is agreed and therefore Bas is discharged. Ed thanks Bas for his work on this.

5. Introducing our new members.

Bas asks the new members to tell a little over the situation in their country.

The Czech representant -Mr. Kamil MALAT- made a presentation on the situation in their country. Bas will send the presentation to all members.

The Swiss representant -Mr. Denis BEUCHAT- told us how Blonde d'Aquitaine was doing in Switzerland.

There was nobody from Sweden present, so we have to ask them on a later occasion to introduce Blonds from Sweden.

6. Progress on the workgroup.

France requested if it would be possible to have the stickers on the animals pre-printed.

This is possible and the price for 4 years of national shows in France should be € 550, 00.

Bas gives the point of view from the board, which is willing to pay. It is very important to have a good identification on the animals.

Lionel means that France can pay the costs of those stickers; this makes the decision much easier.

We all agreed on this, so we will see in St Heliers the pre-printed version.

Opinion of the board: In our meeting from 2007 in England we decided not to do so as there are so many possibilities with Internet. Therefore the proposal of the board in this subject to not change our opinion and continue our decision of 2007.
